



Using the Annotation Tool Palette

To use the Emerald [annotation tool palette](#):

1. Open the [image document](#) containing the annotations on which you want to use the annotation tool palette tools.

The document is opened in an image window.

2. Choose [Annotation](#) from the [Edit](#) menu.

The document is automatically [checked out](#), and the annotation tool palette is displayed.

||> You can toggle the display of the tool palette by choosing the Tool Palette from the [View](#) menu.

3. Click on the [hand tool](#), and then click on the annotation you want to edit.

4. Use the desired tool from the annotation tool palette.

Select the tool you want to use, and then click-and-drag, or click-and-type, where you want to make an annotation.

To change the color used with a tool, click on the color you want.

||> The currently active color is displayed in the current color window on the annotation tool palette.

5. Modify the annotation as desired.

6. Choose **OK** when you are finished.
